Mental Health Partners (MHP) was featured in Justice Intervention: Bringing Services to Scale, the latest episode of Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA)'s Road to Recovery program documentary series. This series explores what services are critical to include in justice intervention, namely: treatment and recovery efforts for people in criminal and juvenile justice systems with mental and substance use disorders; family involvement; recovery support; peer counseling by people who have successfully completed drug court; problem solving court programs; and, education and training for those returning home. Panelists discuss innovative programs to help people before incarceration, interventions for at-risk populations, and how to improve the juvenile justice system to ensure the provision of appropriate support.
